# College Visit Components

- **Common elements:** Tour, information sessions, interviews, briefings.
- **Special Elements:** Class visits, current student conversation, faculty/coach connections.





# What is a Fly-in Program?

Fly-in programs offer a unique opportunity for prospective students to experience campus life firsthand. Available for prospective students and admitted students. Fly-ins or campus weekend visits allow students to connect with the community, build relationships and make an informed decision about college.

#### **Includes**

- Overnight option
- Transportation
- Meals
- Special time with faculty, staff, students

Note: Fly-in does not exclude local students.



# Fly-in Program Details

### Intentionality

- Fly-in programs are historically designed to increase access to higher education for students
  who have been historically underrepresented. Students who have experienced hardships
  and/or overcome adversities which limit the access to higher education. This could include but
  is not limited to;
  - First-generation college students those with parents or guardians who have not obtained a bachelor's degree.
  - Students eligible for the Pell Grant or who qualify for free or reduced lunch in secondary school.
  - Students who live in small towns or rural areas.
  - Students with DACA or undocumented immigration status.

### Application Process

- Essay
- Short answer
- Preliminary college application

## ACCESS TO EXCELLENCE

#### Willamette University

This is an access program designed to support a diverse array of students as a part of Willamette's dedication to intentional diversity of our student body.

Demographics: Students of color, pell-eligible, first gen, DACA, rural but also we attract queer and neurodiverse students through this program.

#### **A2E Travel Grant**

- Willamette University will cover **all costs** associated with travel and participation in our A2E fly-in program. The travel grant can also cover costs for **one guest** to join the participating student. A guest may include, but is not limited to a parent, guardian, counselor, older sibling or any other individual who has been supporting the student's college search and decision process.
- The **\$500 enrollment deposit** is waived for participants if they choose to enroll for fall 2025 entry.

### Pitzer College

- Pitzer College is a small, liberal arts college based in Southern California.
- Bi-annual, all expenses paid fly-in program (fka Diversity Program) bringing students to campus for a weekend of activities, panels, and tours. All prospective students attending the fall program participate in interviews. All students attending the spring program have been admitted.
- Demographics: First-generation, low income students
